Criteria For Eligibility

Applicants must:

- a. Be a U. S. citizen.
- b. Be no less than 16 and no more than 25 years of age on the day of the 2010 Muster.
- c. Demonstrate sufficient scholastic and extracurricular ability to be accepted at or maintain enrollment in a domestic college or university in a matriculated undergraduate or graduate program. Actual acceptance at or enrollment in such college or university shall constitute adequate proof of said ability.
- d. Be an "active" member of their corps (as their corps shall define that) for at least one full year prior to the 2010 Muster.
- e. Have attended the 2009 Muster with their corps.
- f. Attend the 2010 Muster with their corps, and be present when the Award is given.
- g. Provide, with the enclosed application:
 - I. a copy of a document proving their age;
 - II. a copy of their college or university acceptance letter or documentation proving current attendance; and,
 - III. certification signed by an officer of their corps that the applicant meets and will meet the requirements of items d., and e.
- h. Complete, sign and submit the Scholarship Application. **All Applications must delivered to Trustee Bill Bouregy and be received by him at 6 Elm Street, Deep River, Connecticut 06417, no later than 5:00 p.m. July 14, 2010.**
- i. Not be a spouse, child, grandchild, or great-grandchild of a Director, or the spouse of a child, grandchild, or great-grandchild of a Director, of the Deep River Ancient Muster, Inc.

IMPORTANT NOTES:

The final selection of the Scholarship recipients will be made by a random drawing from all eligible applicants. The drawing will be made on Muster Day; the time of the drawing will be announced after the Parade.

Any applicant not present when the drawing is made will be ineligible, and another name will be selected.

Please note that, to be eligible for a Scholarship in 2010, the Applicant must have attended the 2009 Muster with his or her corps.
